The PLG committee is seeking the endorsement of the membership to allow for 4 additional Directors as shown below. This will allow for more PLG member commitment, a better understanding of the working committee involvement and potential advancement in the committee and/or EC&C District.

We hope the additional directors will provide a closer connection and support to the Divisions and their PLG committees.

This document will provide a start for an extended description of the job/function of the working PLG committee.

Guidelines for Past Lieutenant Governors' Committee - 2025

Authorization 1 – 2025 Bylaws – Article 5 District Committees and Key Positions

Section 2 b: Past Lieutenant Governors: This Committee shall be comprised of all Past Lieutenant Governors. The committee shall select a chair annually from among its members. Its duties shall be to study and advise on matters referred to it by the District Board

Authorization 2 – 2025 Policies and Procedures – District Standing Committees 7.0

Authorization -7.7.1

The Past Lieutenant Governors' (PLG) Committee is recognized by the EC&C Kiwanis District as an advisory committee to the Governor and the District Board.

The Governor assigns the task of compiling the annual list of the 27 Division PLG Chairs to the Chair of the District PLG Committee.

A major role of the District PLG Committee is to support the Division PLG Committees, in their efforts, by providing whatever assistance is deemed useful.

Search and Encouragement Function – 7.7.2

The District Board of Trustees recommends that every Division has a PLG Committee which also has the responsibility of "Search and Encouragement" to find persons for the position of their Division Lieutenant Governor-Elect by encouraging Past Club Presidents to seek the position.

The District PLG Committee, through Regional and Divisional sub-committees, will ensure all PLGs will be able to participate in the future of our District. We will actively participate, along with the Executive, and Board Trustees, in the development of the District Bylaws and Policies and Procedures.
